

## Directions to Falmouth Technology Park:

From the NORTH:

Take 93 South through Braintree;  
proceed approximately 12 miles,  
Bear Left to Route 3 South. (Cape Cod)  
(You will travel Route 3 for approximately 45 minutes.)  
Follow Route 3 to the Sagamore Bridge (thru a rotary just before the bridge)  
Cross the Sagamore Bridge...Take the **First Exit**.  
At the bottom of the exit ramp there is a set of lights. Make a **left** onto **Route 6A/Canal Road**. You will now be traveling along the canal; you'll notice the canal on your right.  
Route 6A ends at the **Bourne Bridge Rotary**. Proceed 3/4 around the rotary and make your **third right, (Falmouth, Route 28 South)**.  
Follow 28 South to the **Thomas Landers Road** exit. Follow below.\*

From the WEST:

Take **Rte 195 or Rt 495** towards Cape Cod. Take **Rte 25 South** to Cape Cod. This will bring you to the Bourne Bridge, cross the **Bourne Bridge**, enter the Bourne Rotary and take the second exit on **Rte. 28 South**. Stay on Rte 28 South to the **Thomas Landers Rd.** exit. Follow below.\*

\* At the bottom of the exit ramp, make a **left**. Follow Thomas Landers Rd. to the 2<sup>nd</sup> Technology Park entrance. The first entrance is Research Rd. Keep going to the second Technology Park entrance on Technology Park Dr. Take the first road on your left, Bernard St. Jean Dr. The MBL building #25 (the training center) is the first building on the right (see map below).

## Directions: Training Center at Technology Park From Woods Hole NEFSC

Head North on Woods Hole Rd. from the main lab. Stay on Woods Hole Rd. for approximately 3.5 miles. At this point you will have just passed Grumpy's Pub on the left and you will be approaching a blinking yellow light. At this fork, bear left onto 28N (Palmer Ave.). Stay on Palmer Ave., you will pass a Banknorth on your right just before a set of lights. At this intersection you will continue straight through the lights and onto the highway. Follow the highway to the exit for Thomas B Landers Rd./ West Falmouth. Stay right off the exit ramp and follow Thomas Landers Rd. to the 2<sup>nd</sup> Technology Park entrance. The first entrance is Research Rd. Keep going to the second Technology Park entrance on Technology Park Dr. Take the first road on your left, Bernard St. Jean Dr. The MBL building #25 (the training center) is the first building on the right.
