<p>Student topic</p> <p>Each student will be given a different topic, however, instead of giving a presentation, the observer will act as the resident expert at an appropriate moment during active training (drill/activity pre brief, drill/activity debriefing, etc.).</p>	
0800	<p>Introductions, Registration, Course Outline</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure all attachments are removed from immersion suit
0810	<p>Close calls, near misses, lessons learned, observer discussion.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Test PLB
0830	<p>Station Bill Development (students with assigned topics will field any questions or review as needed)</p> <p>Students will create station bills for the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • POB • Flood • Fire • Abandon ship <p>Mayday review</p>
0900	<p>PFD</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Manually inflate • Demonstrate H.E.L.P. & Huddle positions <p>Immersion Suit</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Inspect, wax • Test all attachments • Remove all attachments <p>Life Raft (all students will physically perform each task)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Set up hydrostatic • Manually launch • Right life raft • Actions Once Inside Life Raft & Preparing for Rescue

1245	<p>Vessel Drills and Skills</p> <p>Single Group</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> A. <u>Pre brief</u> (instructor) B. <u>Vessel Orientation</u> C. <u>Drill</u>: Each vessel will perform a basic drill following using their station bills.

POB Drill <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ POB steps for recovery review ○ Treatment of hypothermic victim 2. FIRE drill 3. FLOODING drill 4. Abandon Ship Drill <p>Mayday Calls</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ During both drills, students will use their cell phones to make a Mayday call to an instructor ○ <p>D. Life Raft</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students abandon ship dry into the life raft. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Actions once inside <p>E. Rescue Basket</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Enter Rescue basket individually (Chad, USCG) ○ Those in water still maintaining formation for rescue <p>F. Enter harbor from a height (only if conditions are safe)</p> <p>Drill Debrief Each vessel will be debriefed & critiqued</p> <p>Practice throwing life ring and life sling</p>
1500	Clean up: rinse salt water from immersion suits and any other item in contact with ocean.
1600	Debrief & Check immersion suit attachments if unable at beginning of class Issue training certifications
